CAN for South Transfer Capability

In response to higher Thermal generation due to the current hydro storage levels in the South Island, the Grid Owner has advised the System Operator that the Hawera Automatic Bus Splitting scheme will be offered from 1200 Friday 7th April until further notice.

The Grid owner has reviewed the following outages:-

- Brunswick - Stratford outage on 18th April. This outage has been postponed until 20th May (after winter ratings). Due to the maintenance requirements, it is important that this outage proceeds.
- The following outages will proceed, however the first outage has been shortened by one day and they are now daily to maximise south transfer over night. These outages are to complete the physical work required to thermally up rate the circuits before winter. Ground work is required before the ratings will change in early May, however no further outages are required.
 - Bunnythorpe - Haywards 2 7 – 9 April 0600 to 1900 daily
 - Bunnythorpe - Haywards 1 11 – 14 April 0600 to 1900 daily
